- Week 1 Obey God
- Week 2 Love Others
- Week 3 Daily Worship
- Week 4 Small Group Involvement
- Week 5 Attend Church
- Week 6 Serve Faithfully
- Week 7 Give Sacrificially

## So here are some basic facts about 7 Habits...

- This is not intended to be your church fix. Please attend worship service.
- People can enter these weeks at any week. We just want them to complete all seven weeks.
- This not a traditional Sunday School class. We hope and pray that after seven weeks, people make strong commitments to these seven habits and LCFC.
- We want everyone who attends LCFC to go through these classes.
- If you have gone through the Membership Class at LCFC, we ask that you attend the seven weeks related to living out a Christ-Driven life.

## GIVE SACRIFICIALLY

### 2 Corinthians 9:7 (NLT)

7 "You must each make up your own mind as to how much you should give. Don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully."

The reason why we dedicate an entire class to generous giving is because it is a HUGE part of a spiritually \_\_\_\_\_\_ follower of Christ.

Please understand...generous giving to a church, is not something that Cornerstone thought of all by ourselves. This is a biblical issue. It's a God-issue.

## QUESTION 1 – HOW DOES GOD WANT ME TO VIEW MONEY?

The message the world tells us is money buys

\_\_\_\_\_. The more money we make the more happy we become. We can experience more out of life, we can go more places, we can play more, we spend more, we have more pleasure in life, and we have more freedom.

Money is \_\_\_\_\_\_ a bad thing. We need money to live. There's a myth that people think God thinks money is a bad thing. Not at all. It was God's plan for man to work.

1 Timothy 6:10 (NLT)

10 For the love of money is the root of all kinds of evil. And some people, craving money, have wandered from the true faith and pierced themselves with many sorrows.

to God. God wants to be the only God in our lives. God wants us to love Him, and trust Him, more than we do our checking account or any investment.

Luke 16:13 (NIV)

13 "No servant can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money."

God wants us to view Him as our ultimate for everything we need and for all of life. He wants us to see Him as our Great Provider.

Luke 12:34 (NIV)

34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Augustine said: "Where your pleasure is, there is your treasure; where your treasure is, there is your heart; where your heart is, there is your happiness."

It's been said, if you want to know what's most important to people, all you have to do is look at their checkbook. The checkbook is a paper trail right to the heart. our money says a lot about The way we where our treasure is.

Our ability to give generously is NOT determined by how much we have, it's not determined by the amount in our checking account, or how much food is in our pantry, or the stability of our job situation, our giving is determined by where \_\_\_\_\_

Psalm 37:21 (NLT) 21 The wicked borrow and never repay, but the godly are generous givers.

The biggest giver in the bible is God Himself.

John 3:16 (NIV)

16 "For God so loved the world that **He gave** His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

God is a giving God. Giving is part of the

of God. He gave His only Son,

Jesus Christ, so that we could experience a life of blessings, and joy, and most importantly we could experience a relationship with God first hand.

Throughout the bible, you can see generosity and God's blessing go hand in hand. God's favor is always part of a generous heart. It gets His attention. It makes His heart dance.

Romans 10:11-13 (NLT)

11 As the Scriptures tell us, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced." 12 Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They have the same Lord, who gives generously to all who call on him.

13 For "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

# QUESTION 2 – WHAT IS TITHING ALL ABOUT?

Tithing simply means "\_\_\_\_\_\_ percent". It's first talked about in the Old Testament. Lot's of people thing giving money to a church is some kind of man-made law. It's not. God is the one who orchestrated this.

### Deuteronomy 14:22-23 (NLT)

22 "You must set aside a tithe of your crops—one-tenth of all the crops you harvest each year. 23 Bring this tithe to the designated place of worship—the place the Lord your God chooses for his name to be honored—and eat it there in his presence. This applies to your tithes of grain, new wine, olive oil, and the firstborn males of your flocks and herds. The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to fear the Lord your God.

Malachi 3:6-12 (NLT)

6 "I am the Lord, and I do not change. That is why you descendants of Jacob are not already destroyed.

7 Ever since the days of your ancestors, you have scorned my decrees and failed to obey them. Now return to me, and I will return to you," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies. "But you ask, 'How can we return when we have never gone away?'

8 "Should people cheat God? Yet you have cheated me! "But you ask, 'What do you mean? When did we ever cheat you?' "You have cheated me of the tithes and offerings due to me.

9 You are under a curse, for your whole nation has been cheating me.

12 "Then all nations will call you blessed, for your land will be such a delight," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies.
